Yacht Club Members Hold First Banquet

Members of the Lake Harriet Yacht club had their first annual banquet Friday night at the Farm house, Sixtieth and Morgan avenue S. More than 50 guests were present at the party. Dr. Harold V. Westerman, commodore of the club, presided at the banquet and presented the awards for the summer's sailing events.

The club, which was organized last year, is composed of owners of yachts which are sailed on Lake Harriet during the summer. Races were scheduled for each Sunday morning during the season and other special events were given on holidays.

Following the presentations of the awards motion pictures of the club were shown.

A 95-year-old general, Charles McReeve, is returning to the local yachting picture after being out of it for 50 years.

And he's going back just where he started out in the late 1870's—to Lake Harriet—to give some very handsome support to the Lake Harriet Yacht club for the coming season.

General McReeve owned and sailed the first sailboat in Minneapolis when he launched a sloop named the Orzole on Lake Harriet shortly after he was married and made his home on the lake shore in 1874.

Lake Harriet Yacht club members made him an honorary member of their club late last fall. His response was immediate and has added a

new spirit to the club. He will sponsor a special Lake Harriet regatta during the season.

General McReeve commanded the 13th Minnesota, the first volunteer regiment to be sent overseas in the Spanish-American war.

AT 95, McREEVE SETS OFF HARRIET YACHTING SPARK

In 1882 he was in on the beginning of the present Minnesota Yacht club, and according to the records, he won the first sloop championship, sailing the Catherine. During the next decade he was very active in all sailing activities at Minnetonka. After that the general retired from yachting until now.

With this as a tonic, the Lake Harriet Yacht club completed plans for the season. If the park board can supply the buoys, the club will have close to 50 boats on the lake, according to Commodore Ralph Tyler.

In original plans and park board estimated the demands for buoy space at Harriet at 36. Those were grabbed up at once, and a waiting list in the club has already started.
