



In the past few months we have felt this love and support over and over again.



From The Commodore

The summer of 1993 was one of the coolest and wettest on record: it never reached 90 and it rained so much that southern Minnesota, Iowa and Missouri nearly floated down to the Gulf of Mexico; and were named National Disaster Areas. However, hardy sailors that we are, we managed to sail an entire season with only 3 race cancellations, just well-worn rain gear. And, being hardy sailors, we still managed to love every minute of our time on the water (well, almost !)

We sailed a longer season in 1993, with one additional race in May added to the Championship Series and an entire series added following Labor Day. The racing series' were simplified with corresponding reductions in trophies. The Lake Harriet Cup, now in its second year, is becoming a tradition; and the first annual Women's Sailing Clinic was held in June; these educational events along with the winter racing and rules seminars are dramatically improving everyone's sailing abilities and increasing the level of competition on the lake. The M-16 fleet continues to grow and is getting stronger (the U of M Sailing Club adds immeasurably to that) with LHYC M-16s back at Interlakes after many years, making a major presence at the Aquatennial, and one M-16 racing in the Inlands.


