




It is that time of year when you just want to snuggle up with your favorite banky and reminisce about the past sailing season.

The winter of 1995/1996 may not be remembered for its bitter cold (hearty Minnesotans never dwell on the cold), but will be remembered for the politicking that occurred. The Minneapolis Park Board planning process for construction on and around Lake Harriet revolved around a community involvement program. When the construction crews pack up next November we will see how much effect our input had on the Park Board and the architects. Even closer to home the discussion of the scoring system was hotly debated. The outcome of this debate was the Compromise of 1996.

On April 20, 1996 the ice came out, this was almost three weeks later than normal. The spring winds were fair but cold, and we all wondered when summer would arrive, then sometime in June we witnessed a drastic change in the weather. During this time Woody Woodburn was observed dancing on his foredeck. We wondered if his dance was intended to thank the gods for the warm and fair

breezes, or for winning his first race in the MC Fleet.

The 1996 Party Season began at Mary Merrill's home (later known as the LHYC Party Headquarters) after the Spring Meeting. When I asked Mary to be Social Chair I had no idea that her secret aspiration was to change careers from Chief Financial Officer to Queen of the Party Scene. Rumor has it that she will hold this position again next year, go Mary go!

Our regattas were not as well attended as past years, and we began speculating that there may be a trend developing. This year we were able to convince Steve Myers, Amy Beeler, Wendy Peter, and John Katics to chair the regatta committees two years in a row, using a progressive chair, co-chair system. Spring Regatta was not a huge financial success, but was a huge success anyway. With only 42 boats registered we made about \$250, with half the boats sailing from our own club. This is encouraging to see strong participation by our membership! The regatta was a huge success in that we reaffirmed that we host the friendliest regattas in the Midwest! The Die Hard Regatta was a huge financial success with the Club netting about \$1000 with 50 boats registered (20 from LHYC).

By mid-season we realized that we had over estimated income from dues and racing fees, and would have a serious deficit at yearend unless measures were taken. In response the Board instituted the Austerity Program of 1996. The two most obvious effects were the proverbial passing of the hat at subsequent parties, and the Club did not subsidize the Interlakes Team this year. The swift action of the Board kept the budget in the black.

This spring we saw our Rear Commodore (1992) Mark Prochaska buy a C boat and move to Calhoun. Mark agreed to come back and organize the Westrum's Cup race. In fact we saw quite a bit of Mark on Wednesday nights. I guess he could not resist coming back to tell the story about the time he sailed his Ford Pinto (or was it a Ford Escort). Hope to see you back on Harriet Mark!

As the summer wore on we saw good participation during regatta season. Lake Harriet was represented in the Interlakes Regatta by our MC and M16 Fleets. This is the fourth year in a row that we have sent an M16 Team to Interlakes. With incredibly strong winds neither team triumphed, but Dave Mott (our Season Champion) won the first place individual trophy. Johnson Boat Works hosted the party Saturday evening in celebration of their 100 year anniversary. By all accounts this was the party of the year with the Harriet team dancing up a storm in the streets! The Gull Lake Regatta was attended by 25 Harriet sailors, friends, and family members. The tent city looked like a refugee camp of LHYC sailors.

As the sailing season wound down we realized that only four of our weekend races were canceled or abandoned because of weather. This was a pleasant change from the summer of 1995. Dee O'Neal was right when he told me last spring that he had consulted with the Rabbi, the Minister, and the Priest, and they all assured him that the winds would be fair.


The Annual Fall Charter was a great time again this year. Five skippers from LHYC chartered keel boats in the Apostle Islands and sailed the weekend after the Die Hard Regatta. Friday we sailed in winds gusting over 30 knots with seas three to five feet. On Saturday evening we were all invited aboard the Johnnie McGetsinger for after dinner cocktails. The captain and the crew were most gracious hosts!

In closing I would like to say that it has been an honor and a privilege to serve the Lake Harriet Yacht Club as Commodore. I would also like to mention that it has been an awesomely fun experience! I have enjoyed working with a very dedicated group of individuals. Bob Sheldon, Jim McCarthy, Wally Daniels, Jim Keck, Caroline Buirge, Liz Fleming, John Getsinger, Wendy Peter, and all the committee chairs and volunteers thanks for making 1996 an AWESOME year!
