In Memory of Peter Super

Peter Super was a member of the Lake Harriet Yacht Club for 39 years. After joining in 1961, he raced a D boat for the next 3 years. In 1964 he moved to the C class and would remain with them for four more years. Finally, Peter joined the M fleet in 1968 and kept this boat until 1990. He also served on the Race Committee during the 1967 season.

Peter was perhaps best remembered to the club in areas outside of racing. For 26 years he worked with the club



equipment, between 1965 through 1991. He also did much to furnish the old steel shed, which preceded the pavilion we use today.

In 1989 the club named the Peter Super Series in his honor.

Peter passed away on February 26, 2000 at the age of 90. His kind, quiet demeanor will be remembered by all who met him.
