

A FAREWELL TO DOROTHY SCHEPERS

LHYC has lost a special member this year. Dorothy Schepers crossed her final finish line September 9, 2001.

She and her husband, Jim, joined LHYC in 1971, owning a C-boat "Night Wing", an X-boat "Raggedy Andy", and an MC called "Red Devil". Sons Paul and Andy sailed the boats while Dorothy earned new status as LHYC's first woman Head Judge. She put the final crack in the glass ceiling by being elected LHYC's first woman Commodore. Her straightforward, matter-of-fact approach made her an excellent choice for each. After serving as Commodore in 1979, she remarked, "The Yacht Club doesn't really need a commodore. It goes ahead and does whatever it wants to anyway." (Wisdom not lost on all succeeding commodores).

As a tribute to her husband Jim, Dorothy created a sailing award currently known as the Jim Schepers Memorial Award. (Next year this will be re-titled as the Dorothy and Jim Schepers Award.)


