Reach back there regularly - just before the start, and at least once on each downwind leg - if you lie on the stern of your boat you can run your hand all the way down the length of the leading edge of the rudder. Keep it clean!


To remove milfoil my suggestion is to carry a pole or stake maybe three feet long to push the weeds off the rudder. One can reach down and pull many of the weeds by hand but you can't really reach all the way to the end (too deep). Also raise the boards to clear them.

First thing is to stay away from milfoil beds in the first place. And if you get into one where the wind is blowing you in, pull the board up part way and don't try to pinch, but try to get some forward momentum until you get through it. As for weeds stuck on the rudder(s), on an M-16 you just reach over the side and clear the high side rudder, then tack and clear the other one. M-16s don't pick up as much because the rudders aren't as deep and the front edge is angled back. The faster you go, the less weeds you pick up. On a single rudder boat you don't have much choice but to go to the back and reach down and clear the weeds, possibly with some tool as the keel boats do. Sometimes you can go head to wind and let the boat back up so the weeds come loose, but that is slow in a race. Weeds also get caught on the boards and you have to pull the board up to clear and let it down again.


14 Aug 2006 10:27pm
